The goal of the new annual awards program is to serve to spotlight the outstanding efforts EMCs and individual directors and employees are making to build stronger communities. From the very first days when electric cooperatives across Georgia were formed, we focused on increasing the quality of life in our communities. By bringing electricity to unserved residents, EMCs improved life substantially, but as major corporate citizens today EMC leadership is evident in economic development, tourism, chambers of commerce, school and youth programs, education, community foundations, and more. These awards will recognize and showcase the enormous amount of volunteer effort and hours made by the EMCs of Georgia and the electric cooperative family—year in and year out. The awards will be presented at the Georgia EMC Annual Meeting in Atlanta Nov. 14. Finalists will be recognized in each of the three categories with the statewide winners announced at the annual meeting.

1 EMC of the YEAR

This award recognizes the activities of the entire EMC as a community leader. How has the EMC engaged its resources to improve its community? This could be in any realm: civic involvement, education, charitable giving, health care, etc.

2 VOLUNTEER DIRECTOR of the YEAR

This award recognizes the activities and projects of an individual director who serves her/his community, either in their role as an EMC director or as a member of the community.

3 VOLUNTEER EMPLOYEE of the YEAR

This award recognizes the activities and projects of an individual employee who serves her/his community, either in their role as an EMC employee or member of the community.
